



Green's continuous involvement in music has become more than a form of art to him. Music pushes Green out of his comfort zone to experience once in a lifetime opportunities.

"I'm usually pretty quiet in person, but when I'm on stage it's different," Green said with a pause. "I just put everything out there. I'm super passionate about this so it really comes out when I'm performing."

Beginning with a toy DJ kit Green received in sixth grade, he initiated the process of teaching himself as much as he could about music, upgrading his equipment along the way as Green's performances expanded beyond the walls of his house.

"There's so much history behind music and so many little details that go into production it's hard to learn everything, but that doesn't mean I can't continue to write or produce and learn more along the way," Green said.

While Green's DJ career began with a toy kit, his connection to music is far more deep-rooted than that. According to Green, his family has always encouraged artistic pursuits for their children, whether it be through bonding moments at concerts or support of individual aspirations. Plastic Mountain Records is a record label created by Green's brother, Zach Green, that supports local high school bands, holding concerts with the help of all members of the family.

"My brother and sister do musical theatre, my dad used to be in a band and he used to be an artist," Green said. "Music has always been a part of my life and will continue influencing me forever."
